Dear Mark,

In our exchange during my Assembly Questions on 12 December you asked whether any Local Authority in Wales had formally requested a change to the local government distribution formula since you had last asked the question on October 9th. I said I would confirm the latest position. My officials have checked and I can confirm that no council has done so.

You referred to a letter of the 8 October from Group Leaders in Flintshire County Council and, for the avoidance of doubt, I did not and do not regard that correspondence as a request to change the formula. The letter was clearly about the overall level of funding being provided to Local Government in Wales. A general expression of concern about the impact of the formula on a specific Council is not the same as a serious proposal for specific changes. I did not agree to meet on this occasion. As I said to you in our exchange I have met every local authority in Wales and I and my colleagues discuss local government funding, including the distribution formula, regularly with local government through the Finance Sub Group. Since our first exchange on the 9th October I and the Finance Minister have met Leaders in the Finance Sub Group in November and also met WLGA Leaders specifically on the budget in October.
