**On 10 September 2012,** I issued a second consultation on proposals for registration of the education workforce in Wales. I am today issuing a summary of the responses to the consultation.

This consultation provided further details on the proposals for registration of the wider education workforce in Wales, which I will legislate for in the forthcoming Education (Wales) Bill. My officials will continue to work with key stakeholders as proposals are developed to ensure that the registration scheme is fit for purpose.

These are important changes and part of the package of reforms I intend to bring forward for education over the course of this Welsh Government term.
