I'm writing in response to WQ80608: Will the Minister outline what plans the Welsh Government has to increase public awareness of the challenges of social distancing for people with sight loss as we enter the next phase of coronavirus recovery?

Vaughan Gething: The Welsh Government continues to work with stakeholders to ensure key information relating to the Covid-19 pandemic is available to all citizens in Wales. Specific information regarding the challenges of social distancing for people with sight loss is vital as we enter the next phase of coronavirus recovery. Policy Officials are meeting stakeholders to consider how to address the challenges. In the meantime, Public Health Wales has a main COVID-19 page which contains all current available information and this will evolve as more guidance is produced.

Guidance on the COVID-19 pandemic is changing on a regular basis and the Welsh Government and Public Health Wales is working hard to ensure that up-to-date information is available to increase public awareness.
