Dear Darren,

I am writing to you in relation to comments you raised about ambulance services during Business Questions on 5 October.

The Emergency Ambulance Services Committee delivery plan is an operational plan which will be refined and updated on an iterative basis. There is, therefore, no intention to publish the plan, nor the updates, which I will receive on a monthly basis.

My officials will continue to closely monitor delivery of emergency ambulance services and hold the Emergency Ambulance Services Committee to account for delivery against the plan, through ongoing assurance mechanisms.

Members of the Senedd have the opportunity to hold Welsh Government to account through regular Senedd business, including oral and written questions. Members are also able to access monthly ambulance performance data, which is published on the StatsWales website at the link below:
