I am writing in response to your recent written questions:

Will the Minister provide a breakdown of what the £80 million for bus support in 2023/24 was originally allocated to in the 2022/23 indicative final budget? (WQ87468)

Will the Minister confirm what the £22 million originally allocated to bus support in the budget has been transferred to? (WQ87469)

The Governments capital budget will be 8 per cent lower next year in real terms as a result of the last UK Government budget. In this context, it has been necessary to review and adjust the original budget. Some additional funding has therefore been prioritised to the rail element of the Transport for Wales budget line.

The remaining budget will be used to support decarbonisation of the bus fleet and our metro programmes.
