Thank you for your written question 92983: What discussions has the Cabinet Secretary had with the UK Government to ensure the use of AI in business, as encouraged by the Welsh Government, is ethical and compliant with the law following the Cabinet Secretary's statement outlining his economic vision for Wales?

In March 2023, the UK Government consulted on its plans for AI regulation to strengthen the UK's position as a global leader in AI, harnessing AI's ability to drive growth and prosperity, and increasing public trust in its use and application. The Welsh Government responded to the consultation and has since written to the UK Government to reinforce our concerns about its regulatory approach.
