Dear Assembly Member

I am pleased to inform you that today I will be announcing the outcome of our recent call for core grant funding proposals in the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate.

We received 61 funding proposals in response to our call and, following a detailed assessment process, 16 organisations were successful. These organisations will be receiving core funding totalling £21.875 million over a period of two and a half years.

A list of the successful organisations and the amount of funding they will be awarded is provided in the table below.
