I am writing to provide further information following our exchange in Plenary on 8 May 2024 regarding road safety education.

Road safety training and education is a priority and funding is provided on an annual basis to support local authorities to deliver these important initiatives.

This year £1,597,645 has been provided across Wales. Initiatives include Child Pedestrian Training, National Standards Cycle Training, Motorcycle Training, Pass Plus for young drivers to name a few.
