Thank you for your Written Questions, set out below, which were tabled on 19 May, relating to the book to commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

- What percentage of primary schools have signed to receive a copy of the book commemorating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee? WQ85187
- Will the Minister explain the purpose of requiring schools to sign up to receive a copy of the book commemorating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee? WQ85188
- What steps is the Welsh Government taking to actively encourage schools to sign up to receive a copy of the book designed to commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee? WQ85189

78% of the 1219 primary schools in Wales have ordered copies of the commemorative book.

Education is devolved to Wales and based on advice from an expert historian which raised concerns about the book's failure to address the early history of Britain, it's old-fashioned interpretation of English history, the lack of historical awareness and lack of clear emphasis on the Welsh language to align with our policy in Wales, we took the decision to allow schools to decide whether they wished to receive a copy of the book.

The Welsh Government communicated details on how to order the book in the two editions of our newsletter to primary schools that were published during the order window. The information was also shared with the WLGA who disseminated it to Local Authorities to share with their schools.
