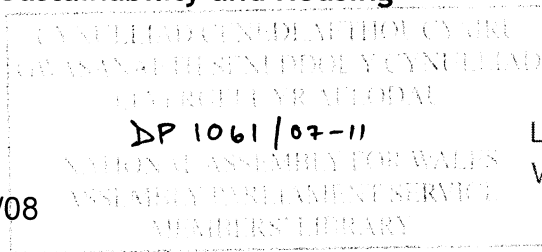

## **NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR WALES SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE'S REPORT ON THE SCRUTINY OF THE CLIMATE CHANGE BILL AND ITS IMPLICATIONS FOR WALES**

The National Assembly for Wales' Sustainability Committee has been scrutinising the Climate Change Bill and as part of this work the Committee took evidence from me and a representative of your department on the 24 January 2008.

The Committee has now finished taking evidence and has produced a report on their findings. I am writing to provide you with a copy of the report and to draw your attention to the recommendations contained within it, which I support.

I am aware that the issues raised within the recommendations are already being considered as a result of the scrutiny of the Bill in the House of Lords and I hope that this work can take the Sustainability Committee's views into account. I am also aware that we will want to await the views of the Committee on Climate Change before reaching a decision on the targets contained within the Bill.
