People of Wales vote against a Parliament for Wales.



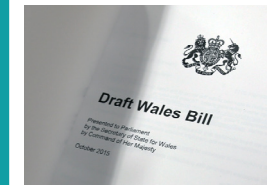

The first Welshman to become Prime Minister of the UK.

Women have the right to vote at 21.

Voting age is lowered to 18 in the UK.

The Senedd is opened.
