Dear Elizabeth

Recently I answered an oral question in plenary in Senedd Cymru relating to the legal recognition of humanist weddings. In light of my response, I am writing to you to express the Welsh Government's support of law reform and to urge you to introduce law allowing for non-religious weddings in England and Wales as soon as possible.

Secular weddings, such as those conducted by humanist celebrants have been recognised in Scotland since 2005 and in Northern Ireland since 2018, but in England and Wales the subject has remained under review by the UK Government since 2013.
