Dear Natasha

I am writing in response to your written question reference WQ84478.

The attached graphs detail the information requested between M4 Junction 23a and M4 Junction 30 journey lengths as taken from the INRIX data source.

The graphs represent the combined time taken per hour by month to complete the journey for both directions. The majority of times are around the 30 minute period, where the graphs appear over 30 minutes this could be considered as the delay minutes for the years 2019 and 2020. It should be noted that delay minutes can mean many things to different people and due to Covid travel patterns did change.

For the year 2021, it should be noted that on the M4 between Junction 24 to M4 Junction 28, the variable speed limit system in operation was changed to a fixed mandatory 50mph speed limit with Average Speed Camera Enforcement (ASE). This change appears to have altered driver behaviour from March 2021 in particular when the system was made operational. As a result, the majority of times are around the 35 minute period, where the graphs appear over 35 minutes this could be considered as the delay minutes for the years 2021 and 2022.





## Travel Time Jan-Jun 2019

**Travel Time July-Dec 2019** 











## Travel Time Jan-Jun 2020
