## Dear Sam

Thank you for your recent written question asking me what is the average wait time for colonoscopy investigations in the current financial year, and each of the last five financial years, broken down by health board.

The information requested is not published as part of routine waiting times statistics, but has been produced as a bespoke analysis. The figures are provided below.

Data presented in this table are the median current waiting times, in weeks, for colonoscopies in March of each year from 2018 onwards. Figures for whole financial years are not available. Note that these data are for open patient pathways and reflect how long patient pathways had been waiting at the time. These data do not reflect how long a pathways ultimately waited until their service was provided.
