Thank you for your written question WQ91624, to the previous Minister for Climate Change regarding what steps the Minister is taking to ensure that all new electric vehicle charging points are accessible to wheelchair users. I am responding due to my new portfolio responsibilities and apologise for the lateness of the response.

Welsh Government has developed a National Standards for EV Charging Infrastructure in Wales. The online guide details a set of best practice recommendations for safe, accessible, and reliable public electric vehicle charging for everyone in Wales, including wheelchair users.
