Dear Andrew,

Thank you for your written questions WQ86402 and WQ86403 tabled on 24 October 2022.

The Elective Home Education budget is part of the Tackling Disaffection BEL within the Education and Welsh Language MEG. A budget of £1.7m is allocated within this BEL for Elective Home Education. It is expected that this funding will continue in 2023-24 and 2024-25.

This amount is made up of £1.1m to support local authorities to discharge their existing duties and new expectations as outlined in the draft statutory guidance in relation to home education, and £600,000 to provide direct financial support to home educating families.
