I am writing to provide a further response to your Written Assembly Question to the Commission, reference WAQ57566. At the time of my initial response on 29 June, there were a number of data protection issues which prevented me from providing you with a full response. These issues have now been addressed, and the information in relation to the special advisers employed by the Commission is detailed below.

Currently, the Assembly Commission only employs one special adviser. The Finance and Corporate Governance Adviser was appointed on 1 July 2007 on a part-time basis to provide high level advice and assistance on financial-related matters for the Assembly's Finance Committee and to provide specialist advice to the Assembly Commission, Presiding Officer and the Assembly's senior management on matters relating to finance, governance and audit.

The annual costs of this role are shown below:
