Oral Assembly Question Tabled on 7 September 2000

- 14. Nicholas Bourne (Mid and West Wales);** Will he list how much funding has been allocated to Welsh museums and galleries through the Heritage Memorial Fund, and will he list those museums and galleries who have benefited. (OAQ6691)

The National Heritage Memorial Fund (NHMF) was established by Parliament in 1980 and is funded centrally through grant-in-aid. NHMF awards grants for buying items which are of outstanding interest, are important to the national heritage, and which are: at risk of being developed, damaged or lost; or have a clear memorial link.

The table shows the awards that have been made by the Trustees of NHMF to Welsh Museums and Galleries, or towards the establishment of buildings and collections for public access. This is from the inception of the NHMF in 1980 until the date of the last award, which was made in May 1999. In addition, there have also been 73 awards to museums and collections in Wales from the Heritage Lottery Fund since its establishment in 1995, totalling £7,637,099.
