To ask the Minister for Education and Skills

Eluned Parrott (Canol De Cymru): Yn dilyn yr £20,000 a roddir gan y Gweinidog i achub Gwyl Tafwyl yng Nghaerdydd, sydd yn rhywbeth i'w groesawu, a wnaiff y Gweinidog ystyried defnyddio rhan o'i gyllideb i:

- (a) Cynnig grant tebyg i wyl Sesiwn Fawr Dolgellau;
- (b) Talu am y gwerth £151,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gwasanaeth Cerddoriaeth yng Nghaerdydd;
- (c) Talu am y gwerth £173,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gronfa Datblygu Cerddoriaeth;
- (d) Talu am y gwerth £114,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gwasanaeth Cymorth i Ddisgyblion - Gwasanaethau Cymorth Ymddygiad;
- (e) Talu am y gwerth £269,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gwasanaeth Cymorth i Ddisgyblion - Cyfathrebu a Synhwyraidd;
- (f) Talu am y gwerth £225,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gwasanaeth Cymorth i Ddisgyblion - Seicoleg Addysg;
- (g) Talu am y gwerth £225,000 o ddiffyg mewn cyllid ar gyfer y Gwasanaeth Cymorth i Ddisgyblion - Dysgu ac Ymyriadau;

Eluned Parrott (South Wales Central): Following the Minister's welcome bailout of £20,000 to save the Tafwyl Festival in Cardiff, will the Minister consider using part of his budget to:

- (a) Offer the Sesiwn Fawr festival in Dolgellau a similar grant;
- (b) Pay for the £151,000 shortfall in funding for the Music Service in Cardiff;
- (c) Pay for the £173,000 shortfall in funding for the Music Development Fund;
- (d) Pay for £114,000 shortfall in funding for "Pupil Support Service, Behaviour Support Services";
- (e) Pay for the £269,000 shortfall in funding for "Pupil Support Service, Communication and Sensory";
- (f) Pay for the £225,000 shortfall in funding for "Pupil Support Service, Education Psychology";
- (g) Pay for the £225,000 shortfall in funding for "Pupil Support Service, Learning and Intervention";
