Thank you for your Written Question WQ90364 regarding how is the Welsh Government improving transport to schools in Wales for learners. Thank you for your patience.

It is the statutory duty of each local authority to provide school transport to eligible learners in accordance with the Learner Travel (Wales) Measure.

A review of the Learner Travel Measure was undertaken in 2021 and a further internal analysis and evaluation exercise took place last year. An internal recommendations report based on the recent internal analysis and evaluation exercise, and engagement with young people, sets out a modest pathway to develop a safe and sustainable learner travel offer that aligns with Welsh Government policies and aspirations.
