*I have been following the news regarding Laurence Fox's awful comments on GB News. Totally offensive, deliberate and inappropriate on a news channel, any channel. It was also compounded by inappropriate comments from the programme's presenter.*

*As you will know I have been challenged previously in the Senedd on the appropriateness of GB News on our internal tv system during Commission Questions. I consider now that they should not continue to be broadcast on our system. I can no longer get up on my feet to defend it. I ask that it is immediately removed from the system and will continue to be suspended until the Commission agrees for it to be placed back on the system. I will inform the Commission of my decision at our next meeting.*

*Members and staff may still be able to watch GB news using other means but it will not be facilitated by the Commission internal system.*
