A breakdown of council tax received in the years 2010-11 to 2014-15 is provided in the following table.

The figures exclude funding provided to Authorities for Council Tax Benefit and Council Tax Reduction Schemes in lieu of the council tax which would otherwise be due from those households eligible for a reduction.
