NRW currently have 5 operational electric vehicle charging points at sites managed by Natural Resources Wales.

NRW receive information from onsite facilities teams when there are issues with electric car charging points.

There are currently 6 electric car charging points installed at sites managed by Natural Resources Wales.

A comprehensive roll out of electric vehicle chargers and associated back office software and operation and maintenance contracts across a number of key NRW sites is due to begin in the next financial year. In the meantime NRW are working to give priority to the replacement of the broken charger at Coed y Brenin.
